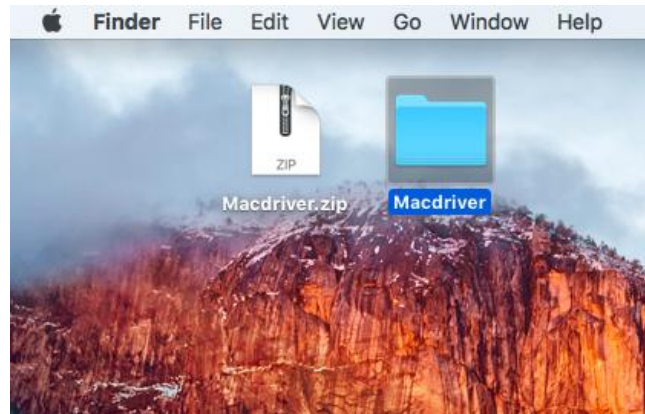
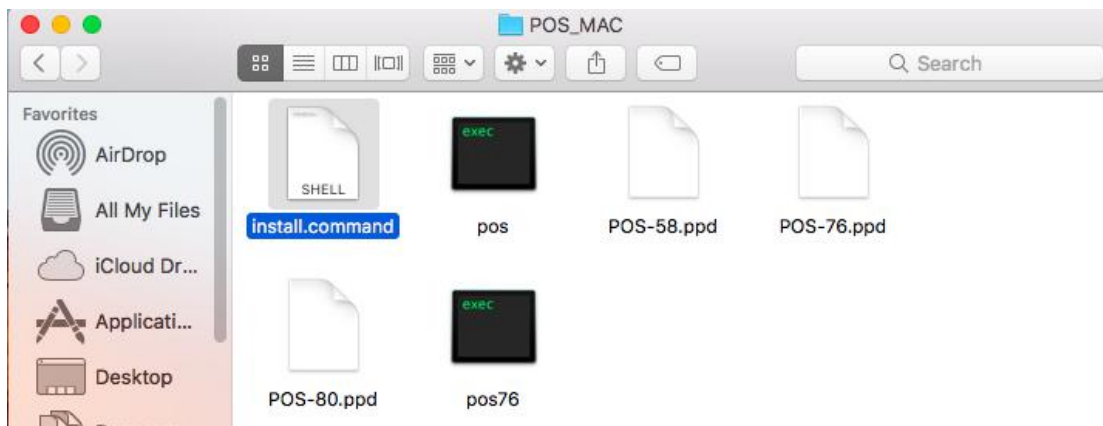


MAC Driver Installation

1. Unzip this file to your desktop. (Notes: DO NOT change the file name or location.)



2. Open folder "Macdriver"--"POS_MAC", Find the "install.command" file, then double click it.



3. Input your MAC login password in terminal. After that you need press enter button on your keyboard. (Notes: it can't be seen during your input.)



The driver will be installed.

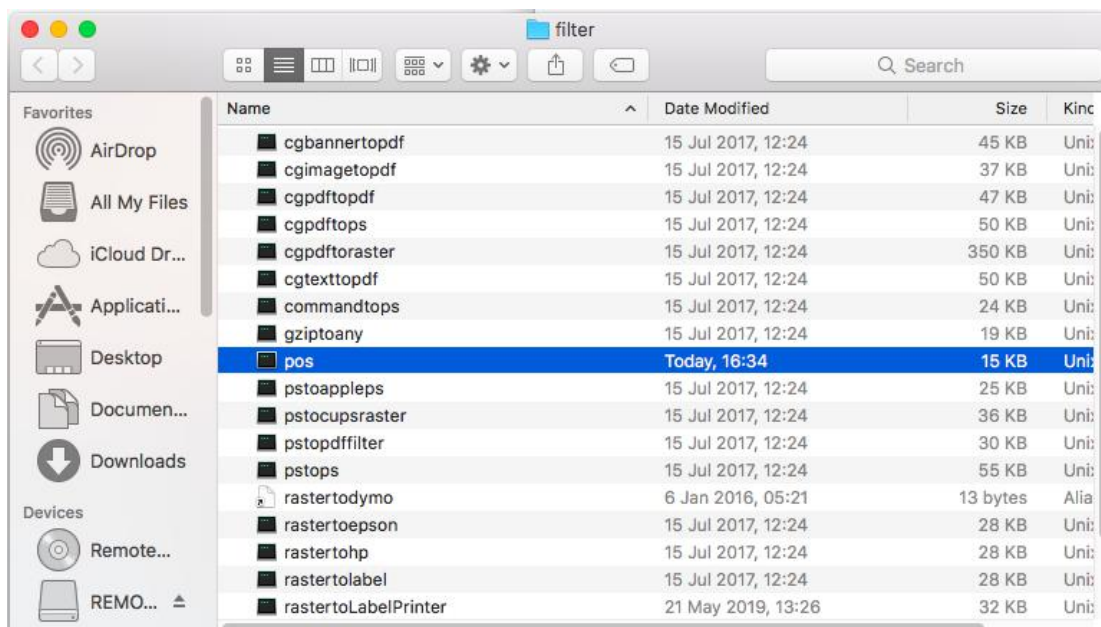
4. If you want to check the file in filter, you can open MAC terminal.
(Shortcut is "command+space" then input " terminal" and press Enter to open terminal)



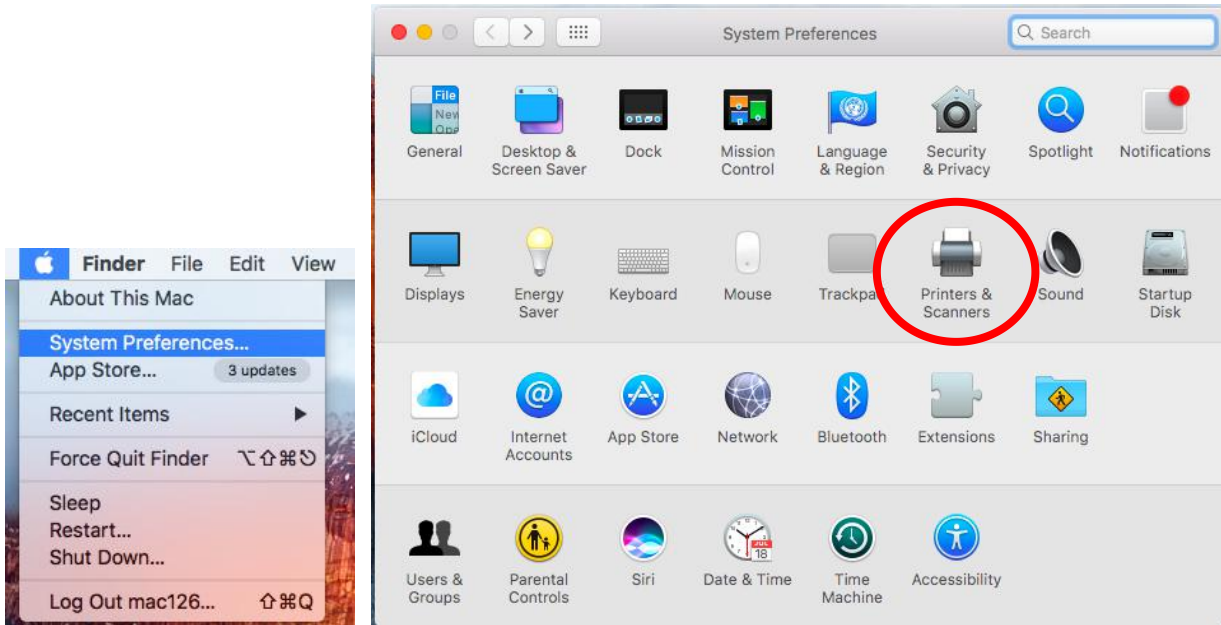
5. Input "open /usr/libexec/cups/filter"
(Notes: there is a space between "open" and "/usr/libexec/cups/filter")

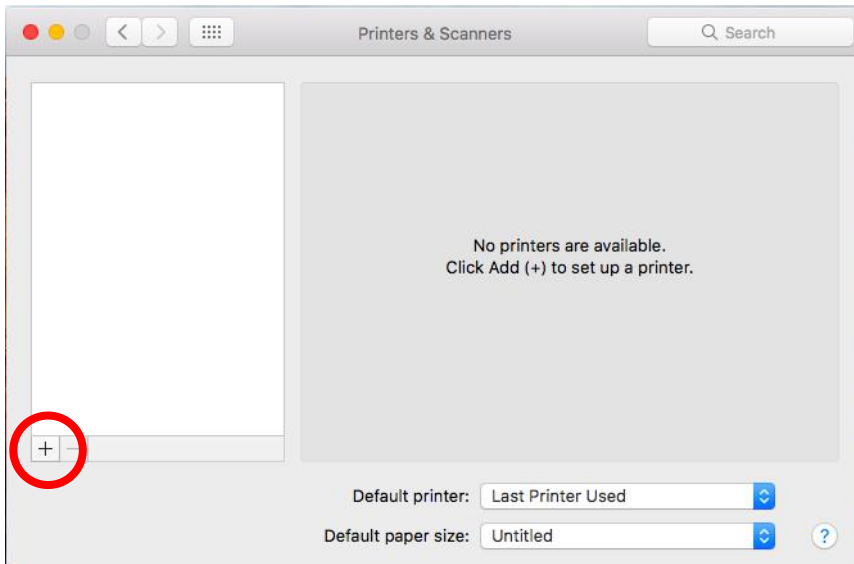
6. You can find "pos" in filter directory.



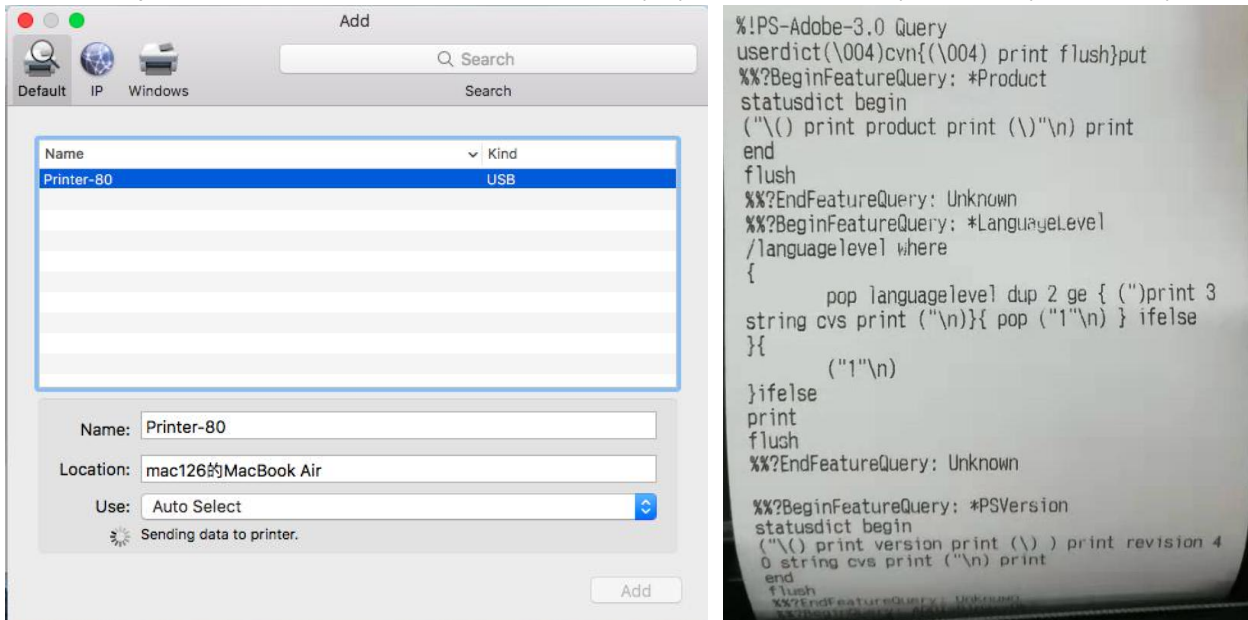
7. Go to "System Preferences"->"Printer & Scanners"



8. Click Add "+" to set up a printer

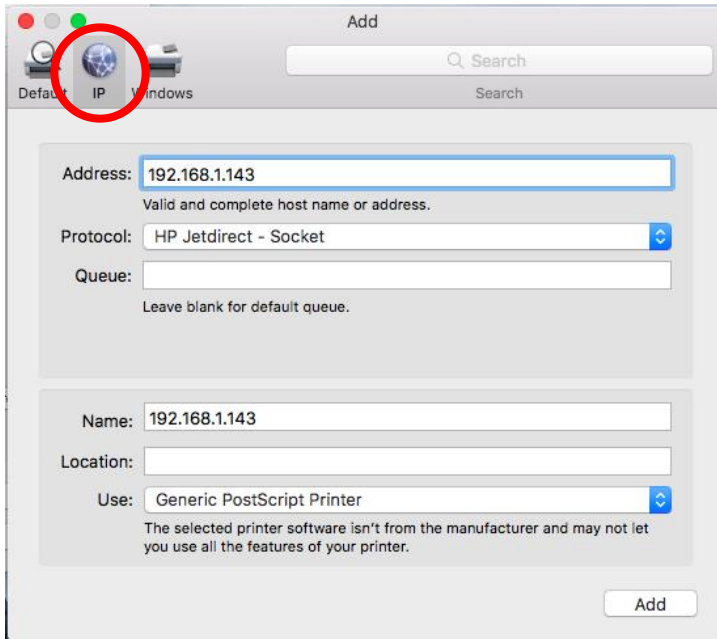


9. For USB port connection: "Printer-80" immediate display, select it then the printer will print a receipt.

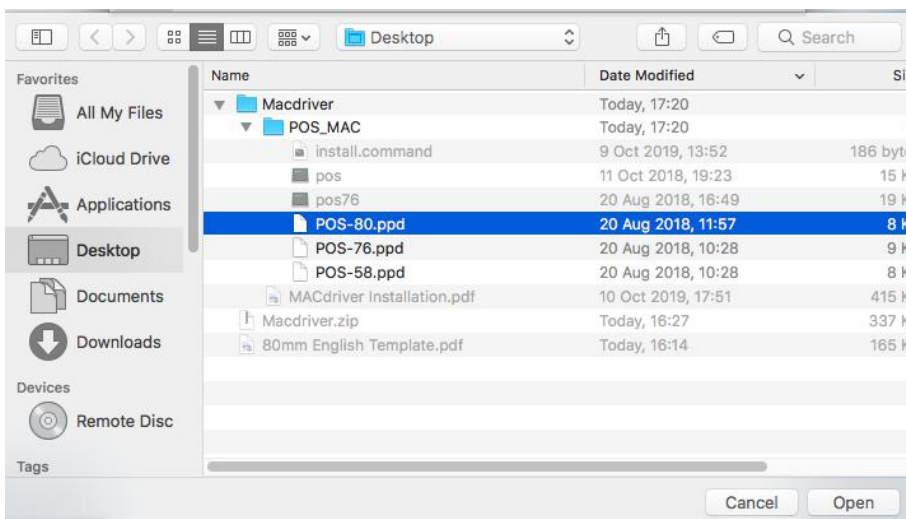
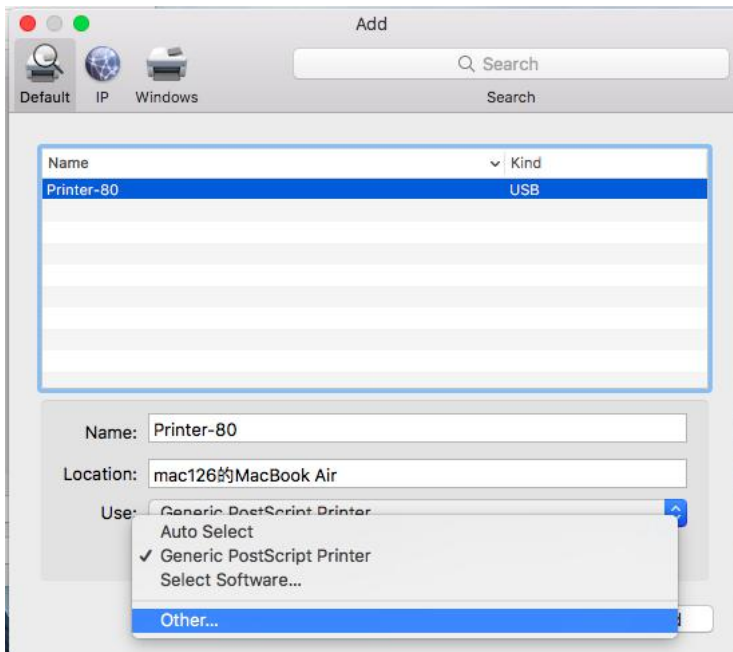


For LAN/WIFI port connection: input IP address.

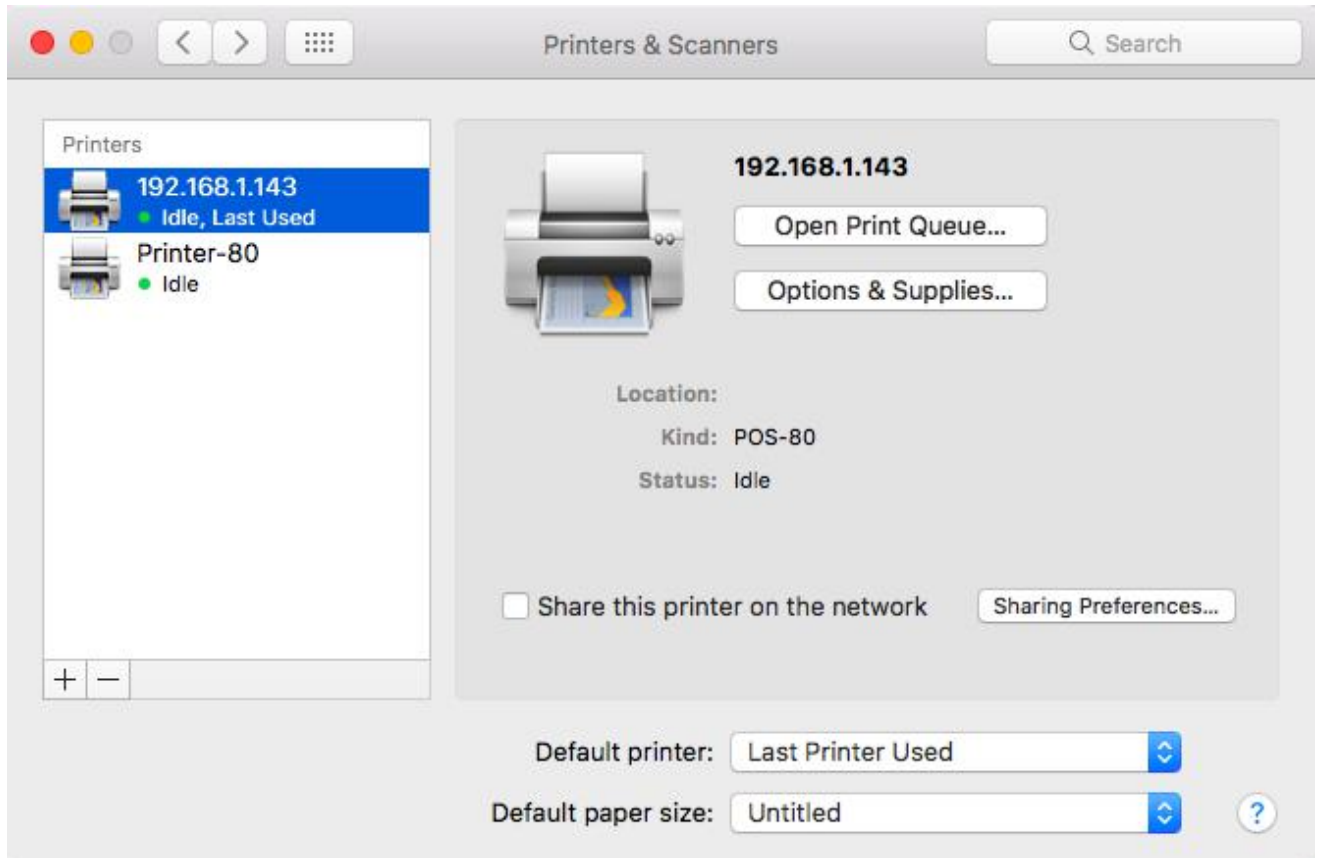
(Notes: You need to setup printer IP address first, Please refer to the relevant manual)



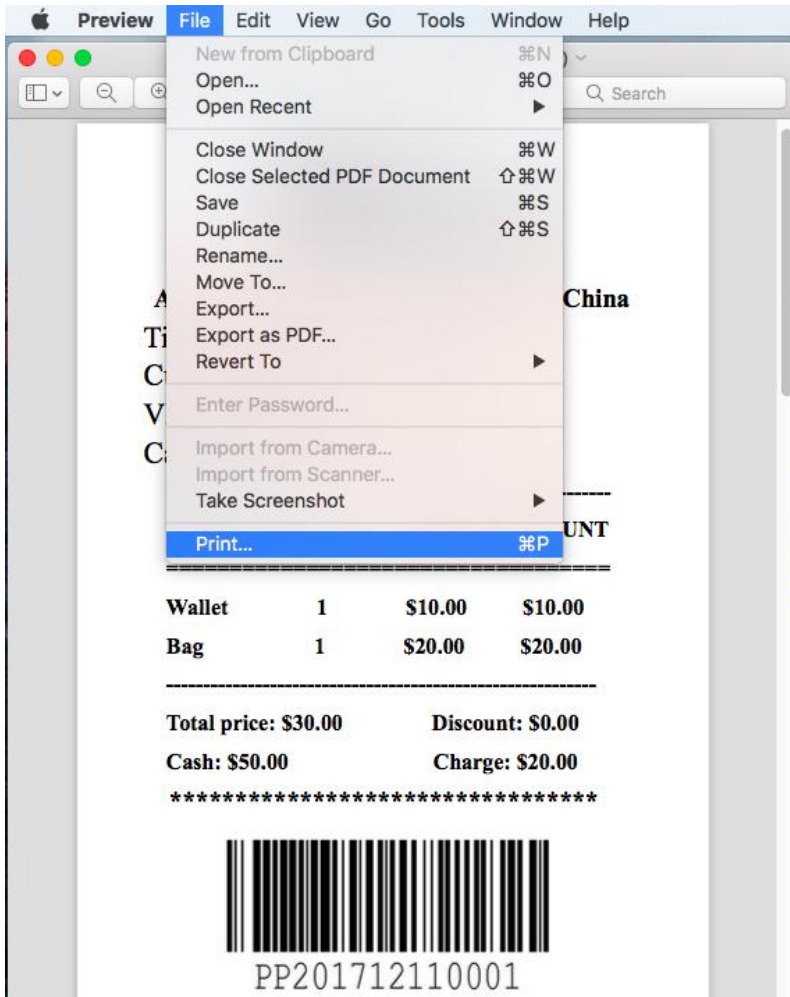
10. Click "Use"--"Other...", select "**POS-80.ppd**" file in the folder "Macdriver"--"POS_MAC", then click "Open" "Add".



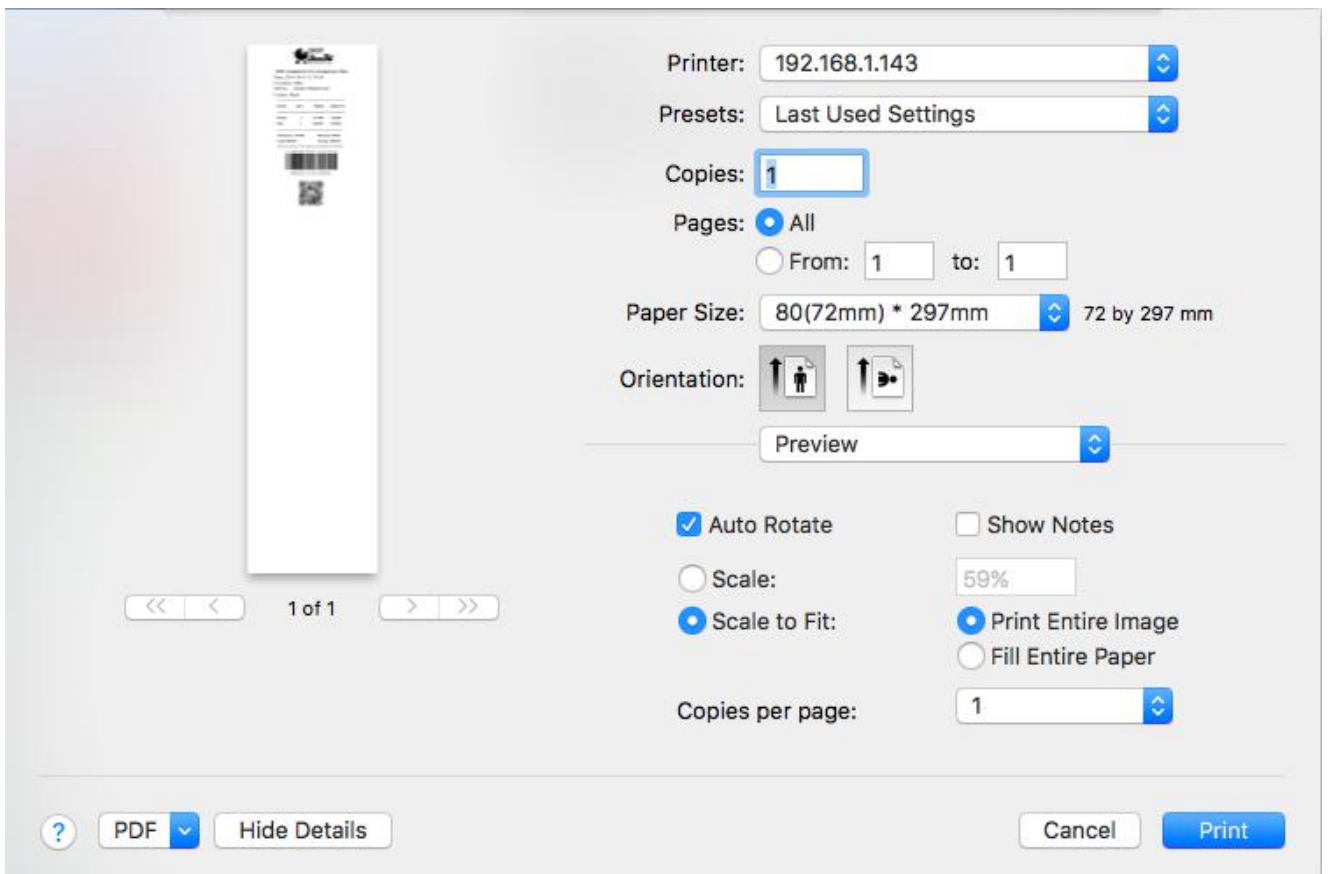
11. MAC driver installation completed.



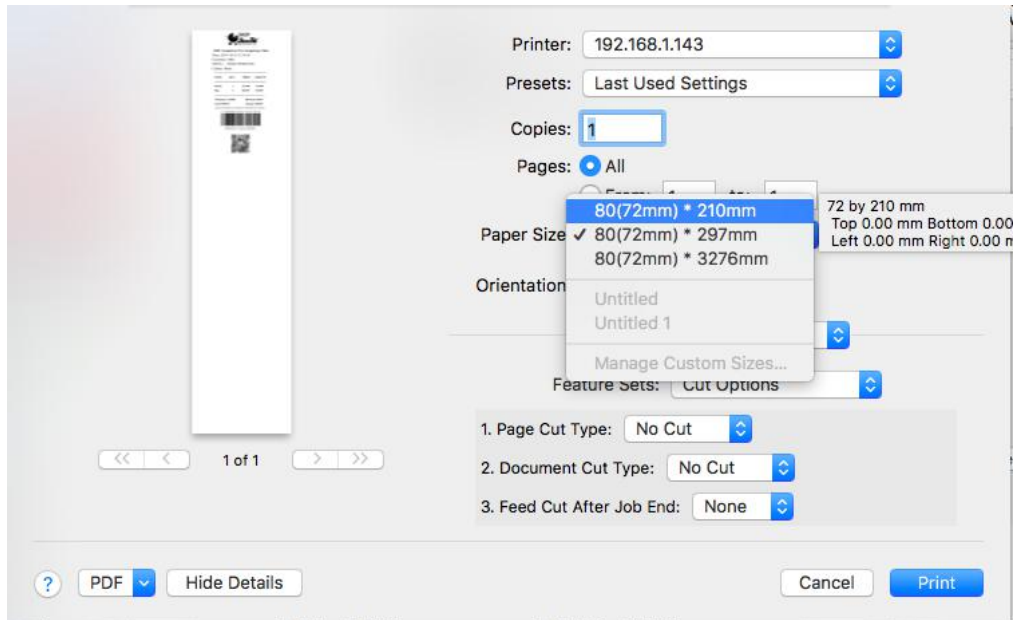
Set printer properties before print



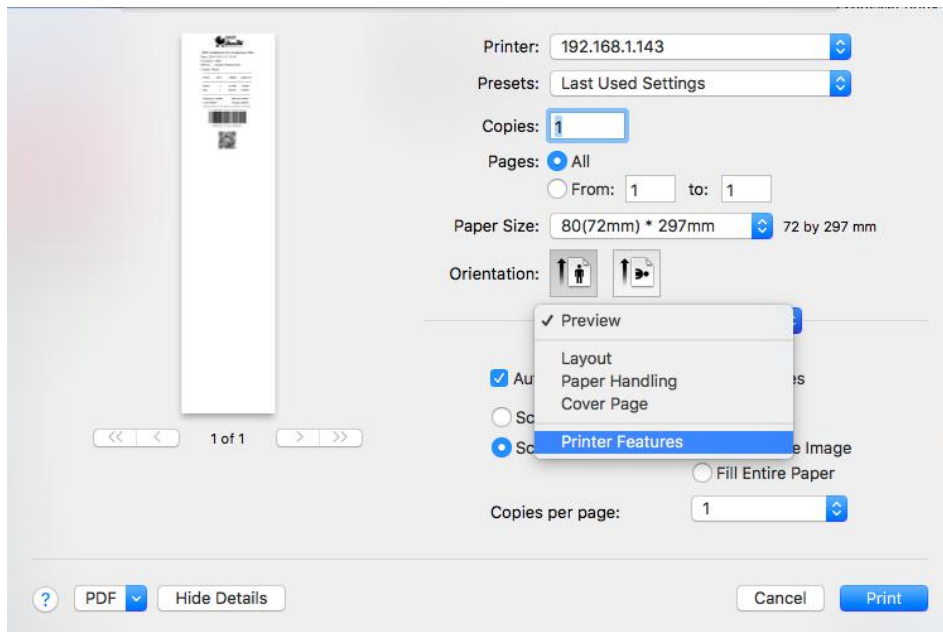
Set print copies and scale:
